POSITION: SLOT TECHNICIAN

LOCATION: Cahuilla Casino, Anza, California

SALARY: \$13.00 - \$18.00 per hour

RESPONSIBLE TO: Slots Manager/Director

POSITION SUMMARY

The Slot Technician, under the direction of the Lead Technician, is responsible for the maintenance and repair of all gaming machines on the floor of Cahuilla Casino during his/her assigned shift.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Evaluate machines which fail to hold approved percentages or which fail to reach expectations.
2. Perform minor and major repairs on slot and video games, scheduled and un-scheduled.
3. Examine all gaming related equipment for evidence of cheating and mechanical malfunctions.
4. Keep complete records listing repairs of department equipment in accordance with department policies and procedures.
5. Keep all lines of communication open, regarding duties.
6. Perform preventive maintenance to ensure maximum machine performance.
7. Monitor and repair slot tracking system as needed.
8. Move and install gaming devices as needed.
9. All other duties as assigned by Director of Slot Operations

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Minimum one (2) years experience in electronics repair or in the gaming industry.
2. Strong mathematical skills.
3. Excellent customer service skills.
4. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
5. Able to lift 50 lbs.
6. Willingness to attend trainings.
7. Able to train for and pass Title 31 exam.
8. Able to work in a Loud and Smoke filled environment.
9. Able to obtain and retain gaming license through the Cahuilla Tribal Gaming Agency.
10. High School Diploma or equivalent.
11. Able to read and understand interact par sheets and calculate payout percentages.
12. Computer literate.
13. Able to obtain and retain gaming license through the Cahuilla Tribal Gaming Agency.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS/WORKING CONDITINS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions of their job.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to walk, sit, use hands to finger, handle or feel, reach with hands and arms, climb or balance, stoop or bend, and speak and hear. Specific vision abilities required by the job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

While performing the essential functions of this position, the employee is occasionally exposed to outdoor weather conditions and required to move about he Casino floor and exposed to a non-smoke free environment.

Cahuilla Casino is committed to a drug and alcohol free workplace. Any job offer is conditional upon successful passing of a pre-employment drug test and must qualify for a Cahuilla Gaming License, which includes an extensive background security check.

If none of the applicants should meet the stated qualifications, applicants whose education and experience are less than the stated requirements, may be interviewed and hired provided the applicant hired submits a formal written training plan within (30) thirty days which can be completed within a "reasonable time" agreed upon by the supervisor and the applicant. Applicants who are hired and fail t meet the agreed upon formal training program, will be discharged upon failure to complete the specified training as so scheduled.

A drug test will be required prior to employment and periodically thereafter.

NOTE

This description incorporates the most typical duties performed. It is recognized that other duties not specifically mentioned may also be performed. The inclusion of these duties would not alter the overall evaluation of the position.
